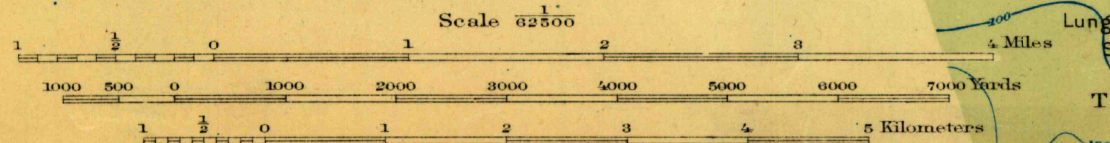


Vertical scale on the left side of the map, marked from 0 to 15 miles.
