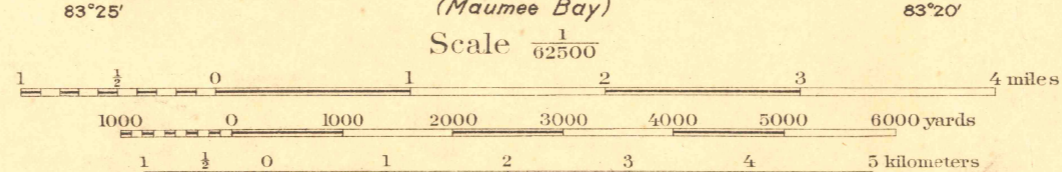
MICHIGAN

PROGRESSIVE MILITARY MAP



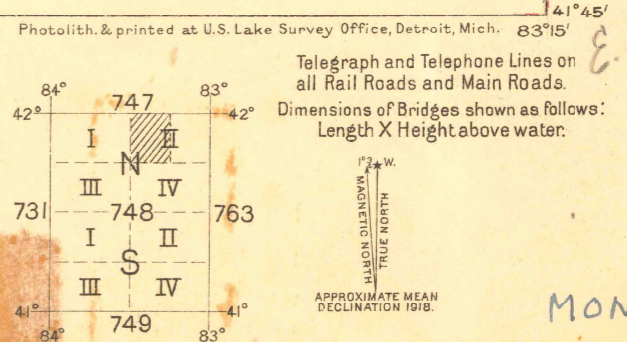
