TO ONE A STANDARD REFERENCE ON THIS SHEET TO NEAREST 100 METERS

SAMPLE POINT: SYRBERG

1. Read letters identifying 100,000 meter square in which the point lies.
2. Locate first VERTICAL grid line to LEFT of point and read LARGE figure labeling the line within in the top or bottom margin, or on the line itself.
3. Estimate tenths from grid line to point.
4. Locate first HORIZONTAL grid line BELOW point and read LARGE figure labeling the line within in the left or right margin, or on the line itself.
5. Estimate tenths from grid line to point.
