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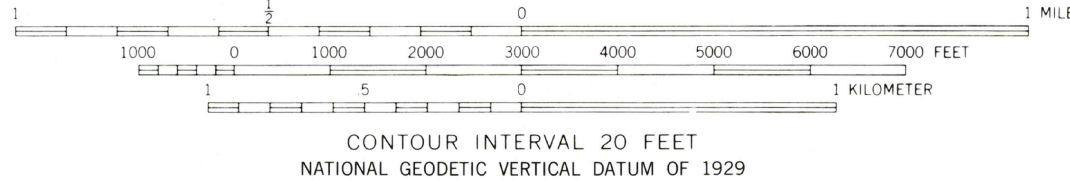
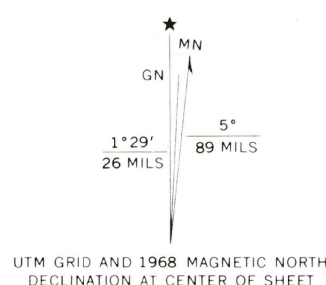
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1966. Field checked 1968

There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map

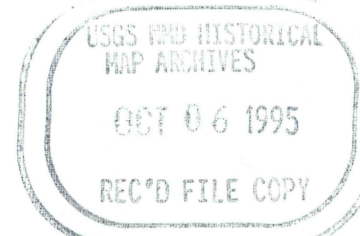
