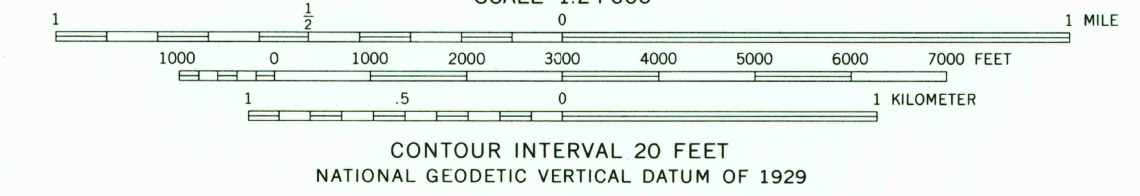
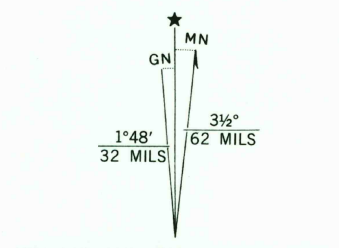
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 16 1927 North American Datum
