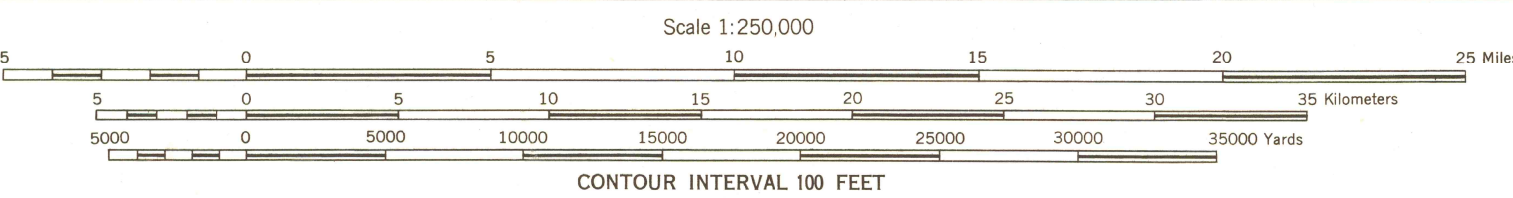

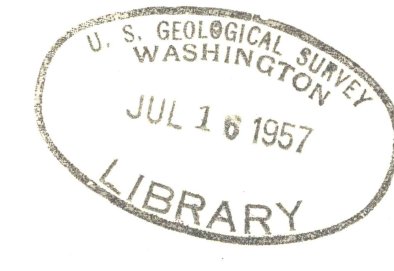
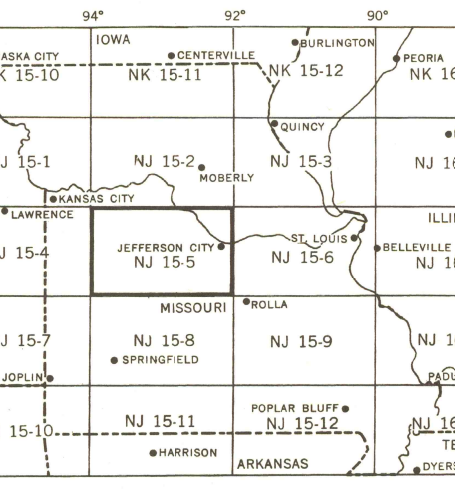
TOWNSHIP OR RANGE LINE
