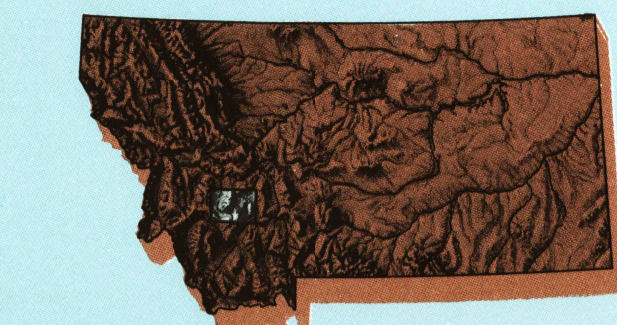


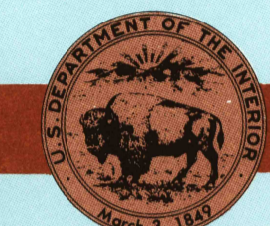
Butte North MONTANA

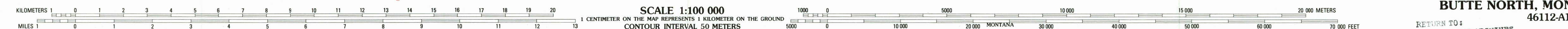
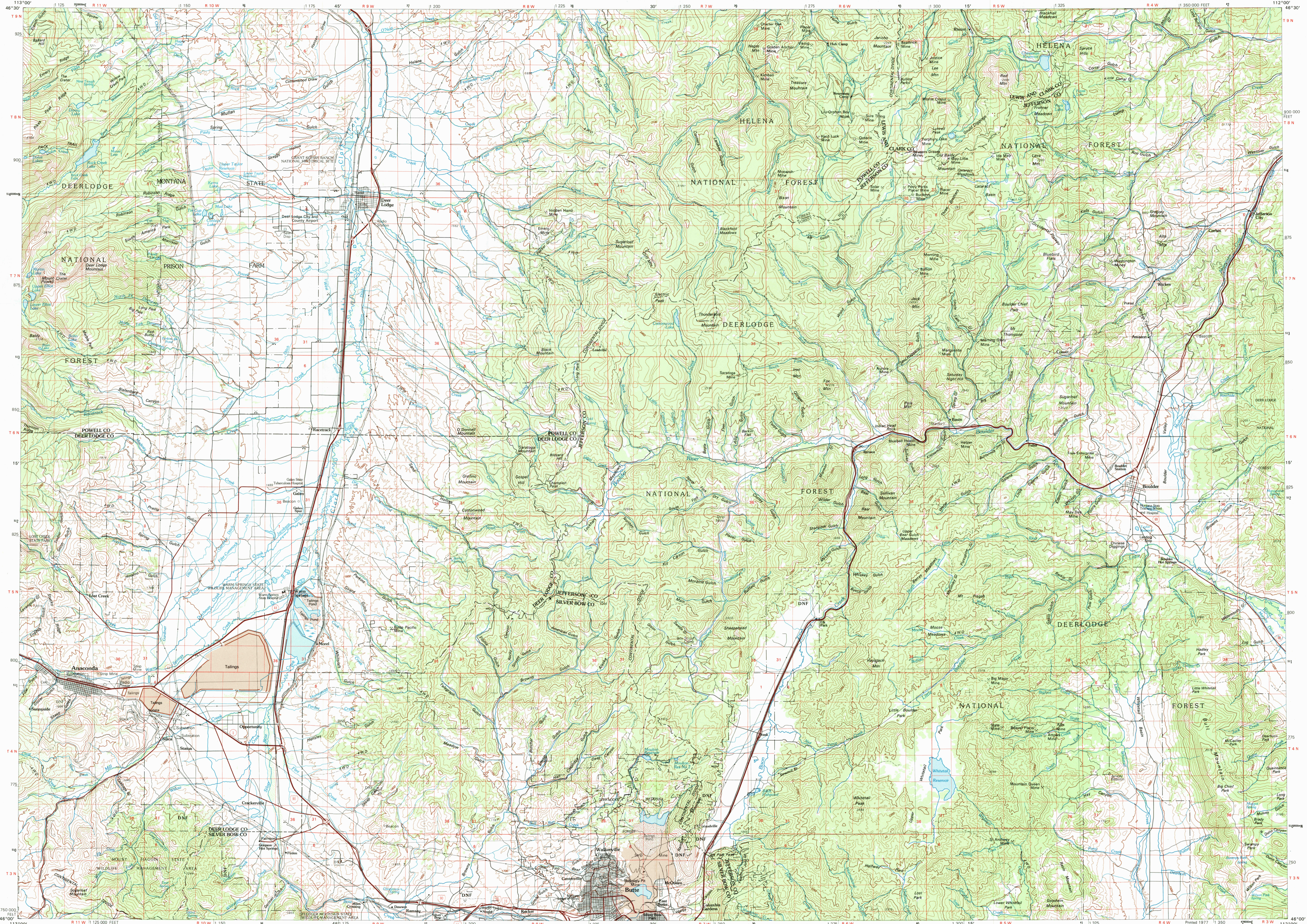
