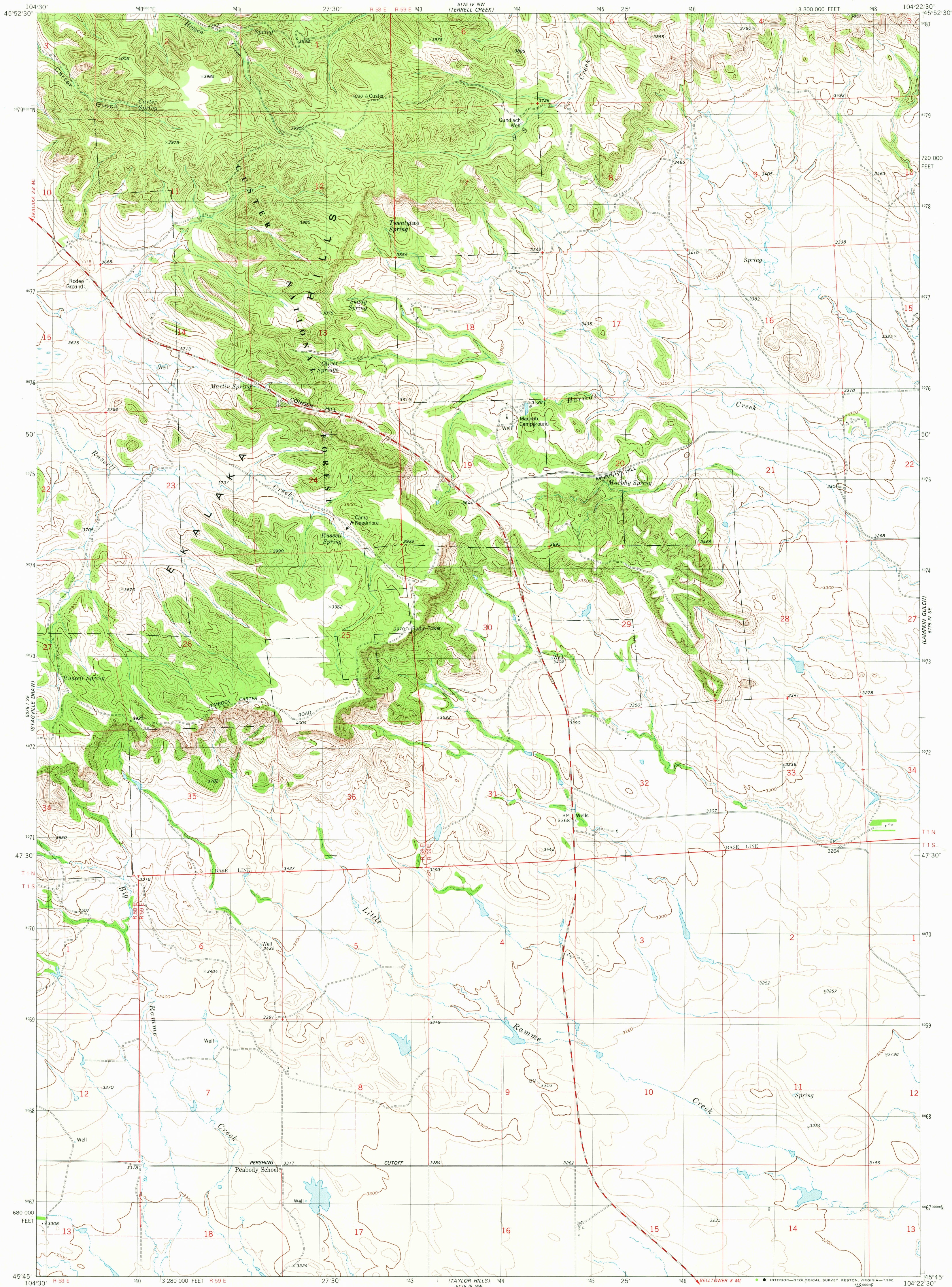

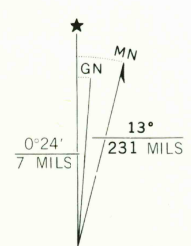
Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Montana coordinate system, south zone (Lambert conformal conic)

There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map

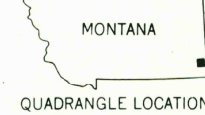
