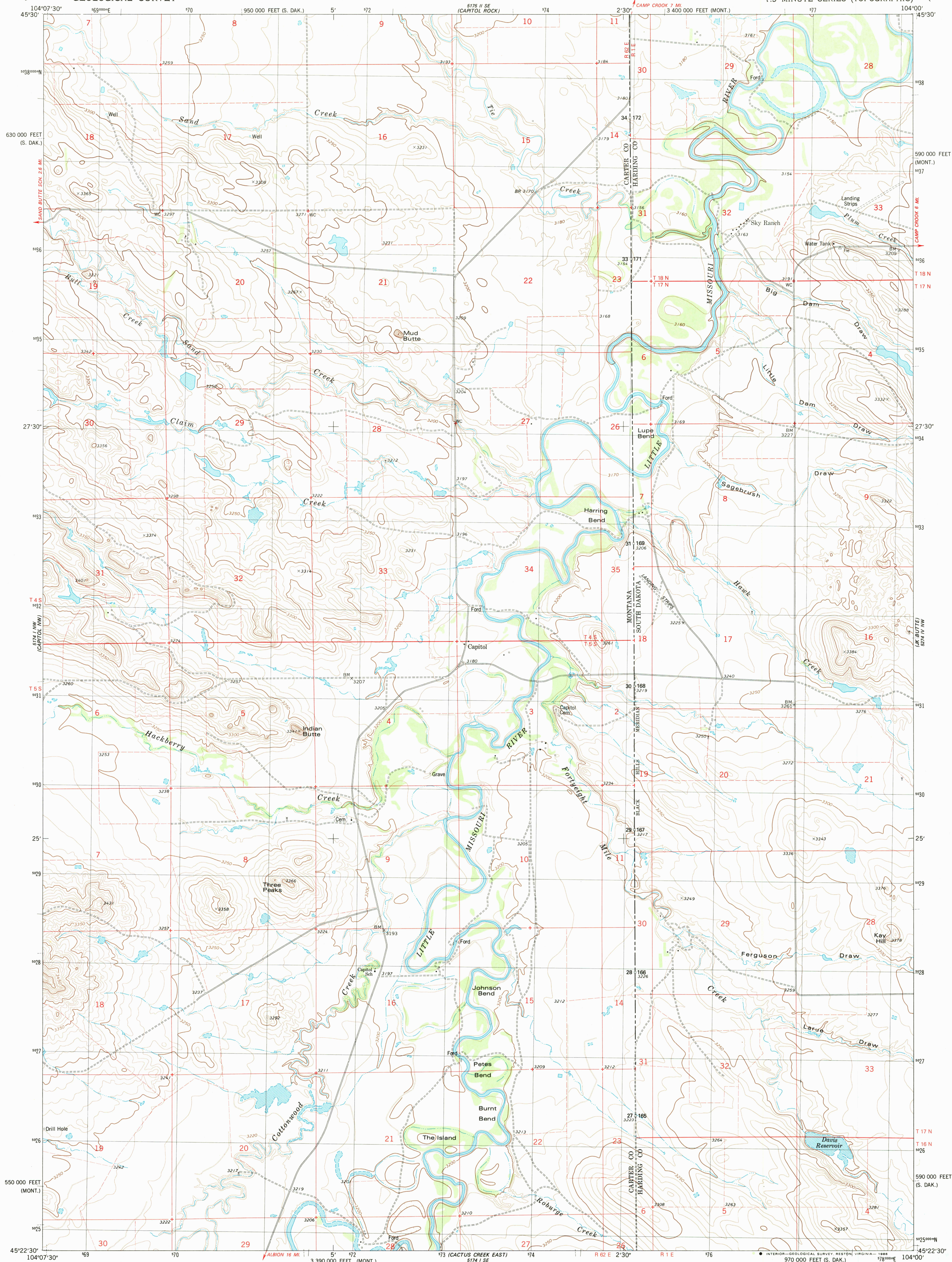

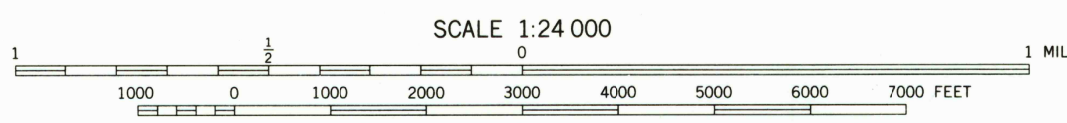
10,000-foot grid ticks based on Montana coordinate system, south zone and South Dakota coordinate system, north zone

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 13

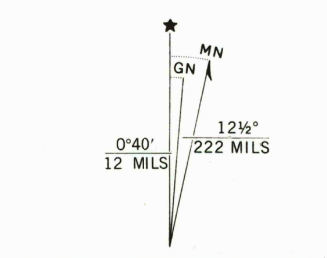
1927 North American Datum
