Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Montana coordinate system, north and central zones. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue. Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 2 meters north and 39 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
