

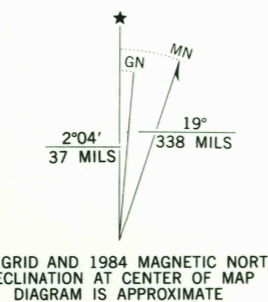

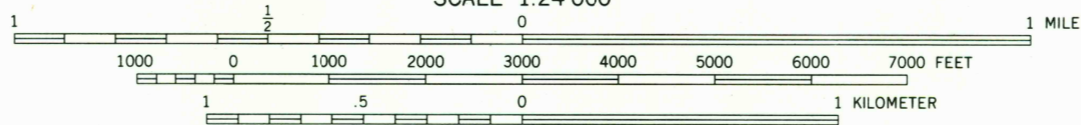
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 12 meters north and 71 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
