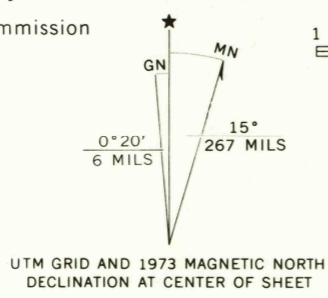

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Montana coordinate system, north zone (Lambert conformal conic)

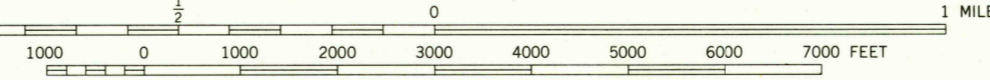
1000-metre Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue. 1927 North American datum
