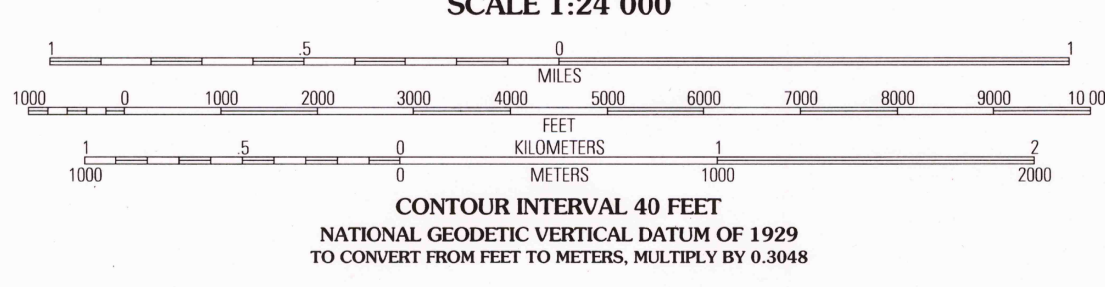
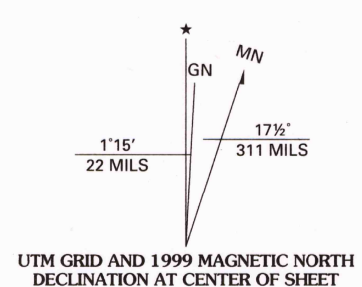




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HISTORICAL MAP ARCHIVES

North American Datum of 1927 (NAD 27). Projection and 10 000-foot ticks: Montana coordinate system, central zone (Lambert conformal conic). Blue 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator ticks, zone 11.
North American Datum of 1983 (NAD 83) is shown by dashed corner ticks. The values of the shift between NAD 27 and NAD 83 for 7.5-minute intersections are obtainable from National Geodetic Survey NADCON software.
