

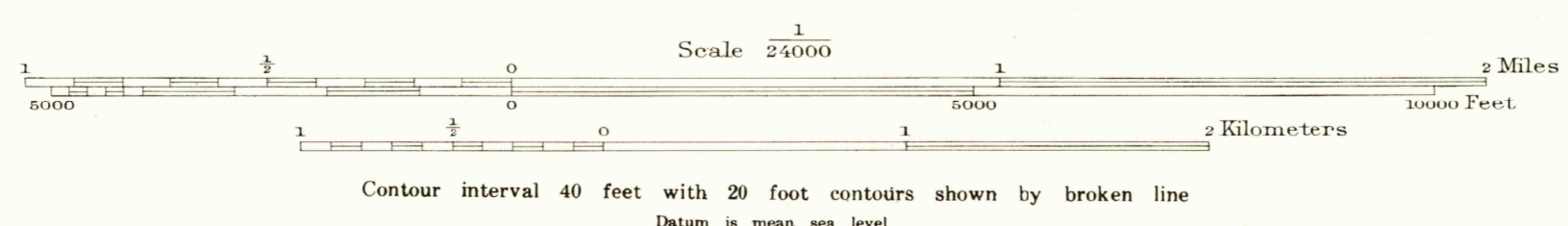
THIS AREA IS SHOWN ON THE U.S. GEOLOGICAL SURVEY MAP OF
