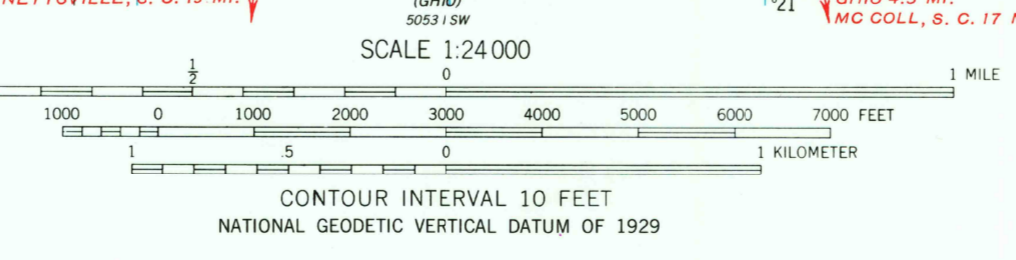

Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1948. Culture and drainage revised from aerial photographs taken 1955-1956. Field checked 1957  
Polyconic projection. 10,000-foot grid ticks based on North Carolina coordinate system. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue. 1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 12 meters south and 20 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks  
Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown  
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
