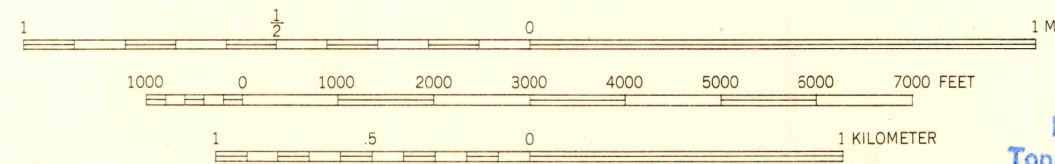
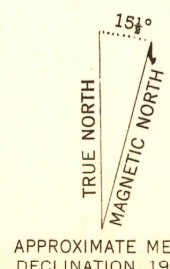

North Zone

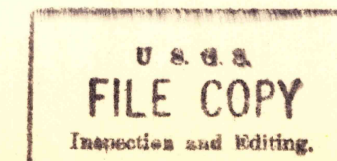
