G. GRID ZONE DESIGNATION:

100,000 Meters

IGNORE THE SMALLER figure of any grid number: there are four grid numbers in the grid coordinates. Use ONLY the LARGER figure of the grid number, example: 5290000

TO GIVE A STANDARD REFERENCE TO THIS SHEET TO NEAREST 100 METERS

SAMPLE POINT: ROSE HILL SCHOOL.

1. Read letters identifying 100000 meter square in the point line:
 MK for first VERTICAL and NJ for LEFT of point and read LARGEST figure labeling the letter in the top or bottom number, as on the line itself:

2. Estimate letters from grid line to point:
 Estimate letters HORIZONTAL and ONE BELOW point and read LARGEST figure labeling the letter in the left or right number, as on the line itself:

3. Locate letter from grid line to point:
 Estimate letters from grid line to point:

If reporting beyond 19 in any direction, prefix Grid Zone Designation, as: **44UN1985**
