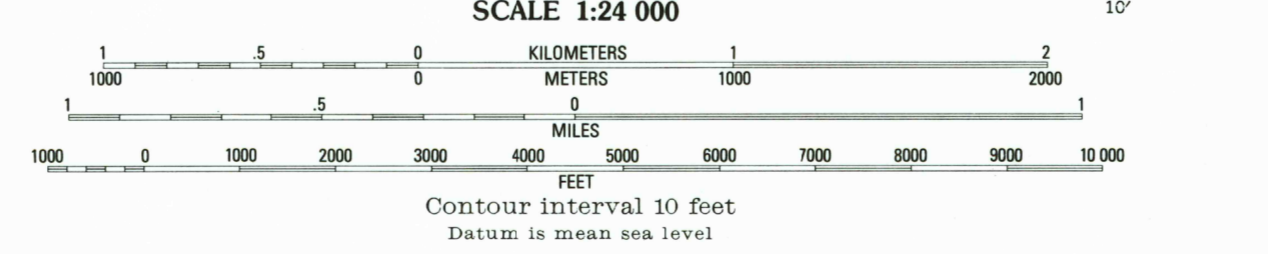

ROAD CLASSIFICATION 1947: On weather mats, Low-surface graded, Unsurfaced, Graded, State Route, U.S. Route.

APPROXIMATE MEAN DECLINATION, 1946: TRUE NORTH, MAGNETIC NORTH, 20% TOTAL COVERED FIBER.
