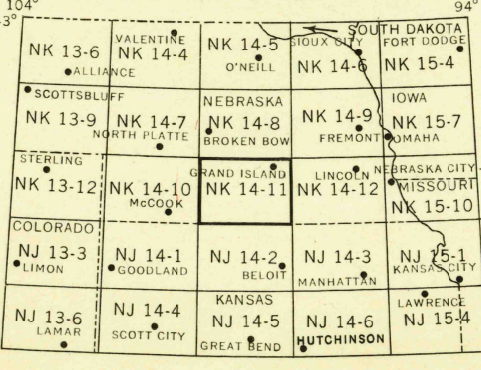

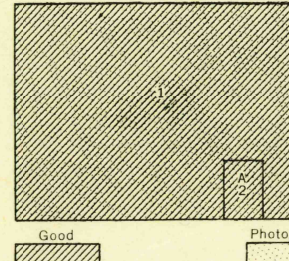

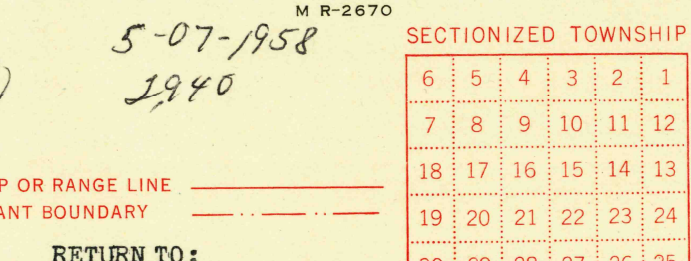
LOCATION DIAGRAM FOR NK 14-11
