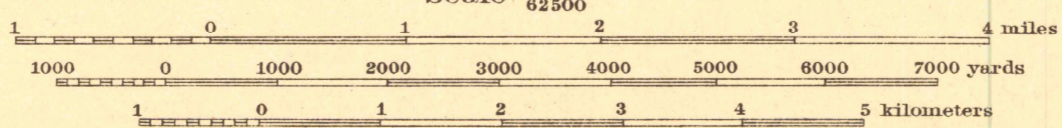




Base map from U. S. G. S. engravings.

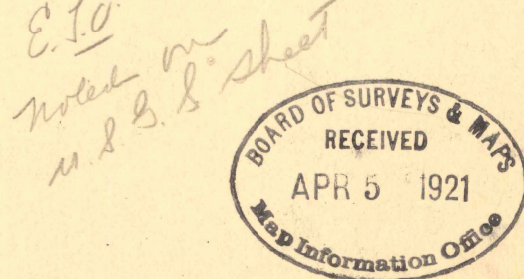
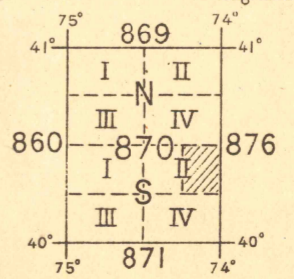
