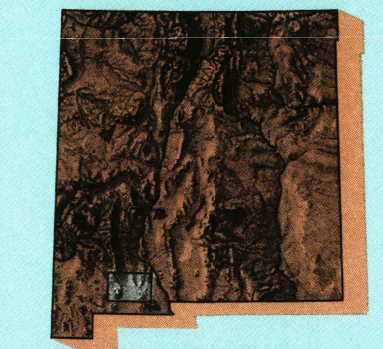
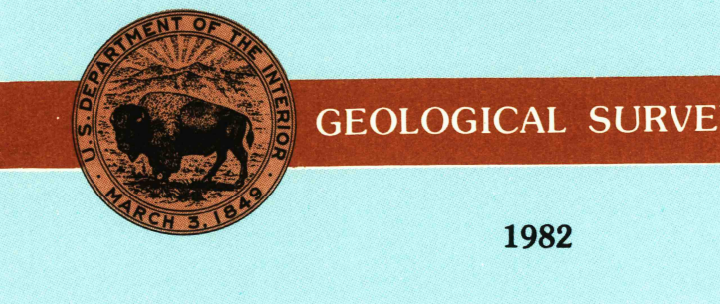


1:100 000-scale metric topographic map of **Deming** NEW MEXICO
