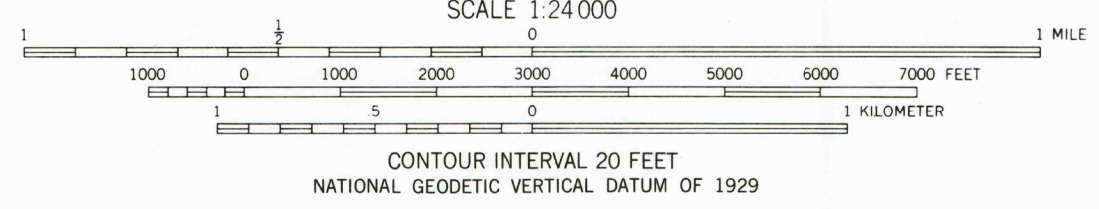
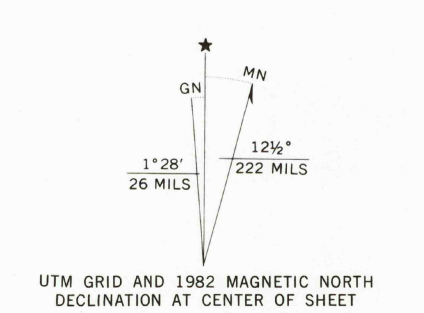

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 2 meters north and 54 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
Areas covered by dashed light purple pattern are subject to controlled inundation to 6101 feet
