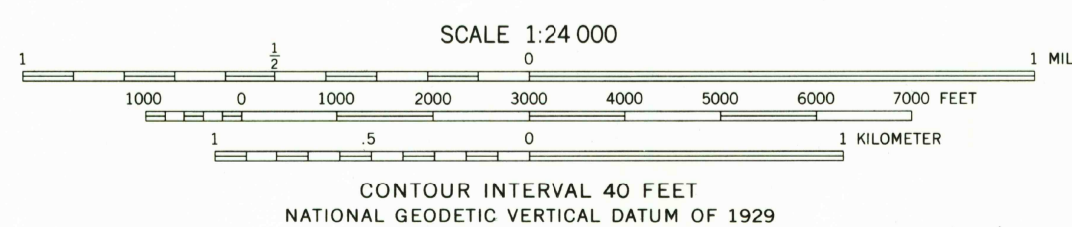
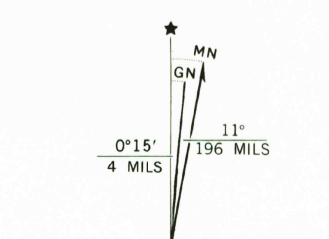
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 5 meters south and 49 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation

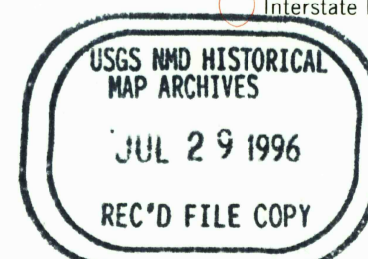
