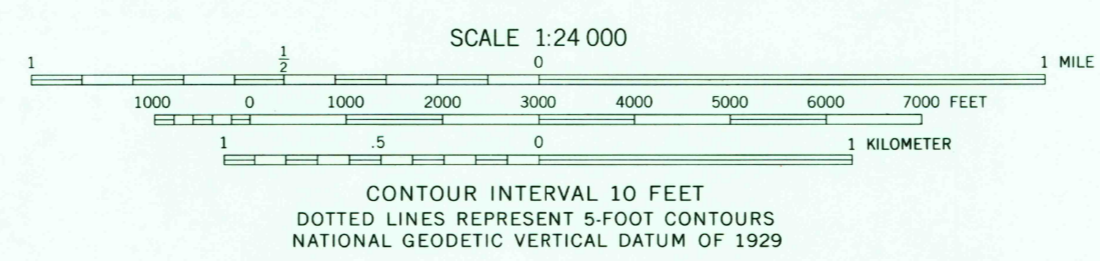
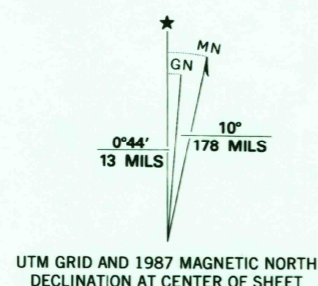

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 5 meters south and 46 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
Land lines, in part, are based on cultural developments and are not reflected in the original land survey
