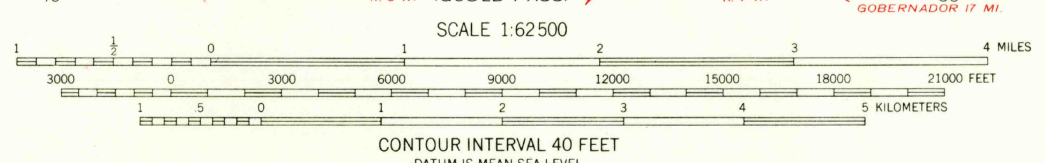


Mapped, edited, and published by the Geological Survey

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on New Mexico coordinate system, west and central zones.  
1000 meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue.  
Blue hatching indicates area to be submerged by Navajo Reservoir at elevation 5990 feet.  
Area covered by dashed light blue pattern is subject to controlled inundation to 6101 feet.
