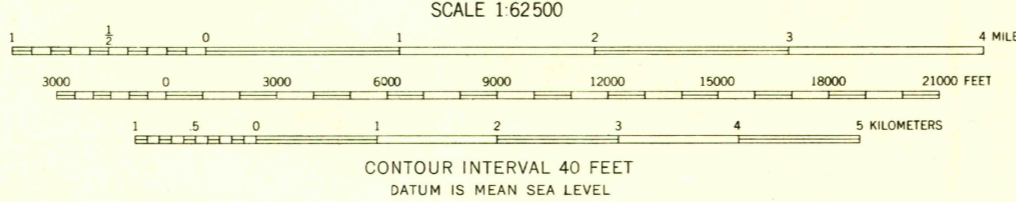




Mapped, edited and published by the Geological Survey
