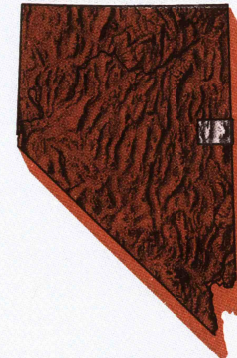


Kern Mountains NEVADA-UTAH

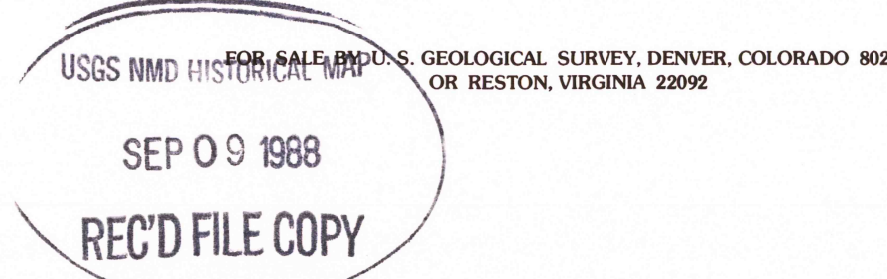
