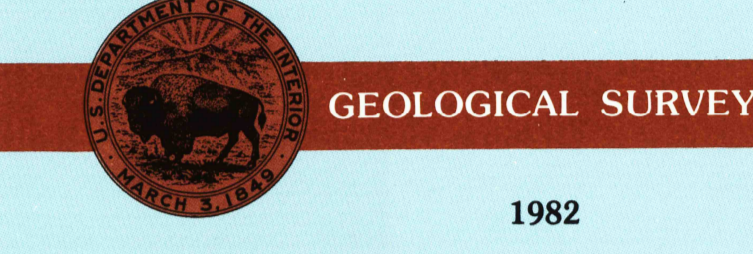


1:100 000-scale metric topographic map of Wilson Creek Range NEVADA-UTAH
