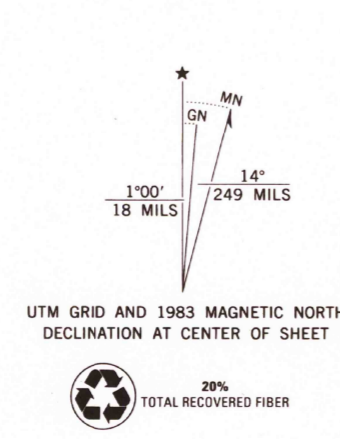

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Nevada coordinate system, east zone (transverse Mercator)
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 11, shown in blue 1927 North American Datum
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 5 meters north and 75 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown
Certain land lines are omitted because of insufficient data
