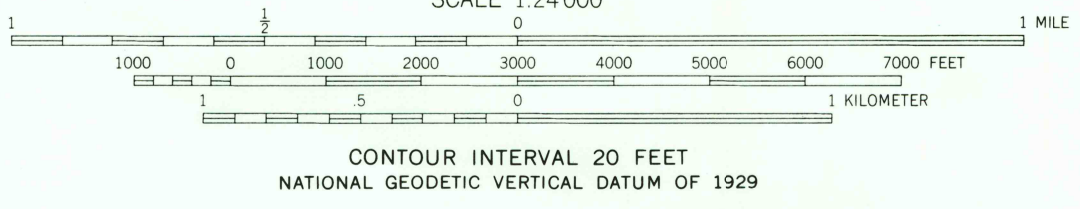
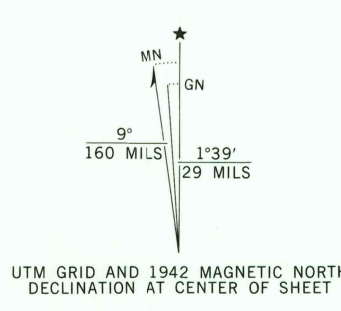

move the projection lines 3 meters south and 24 meters  
west as shown by dashed corner ticks  
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of  
the National or State reservations shown on this map
