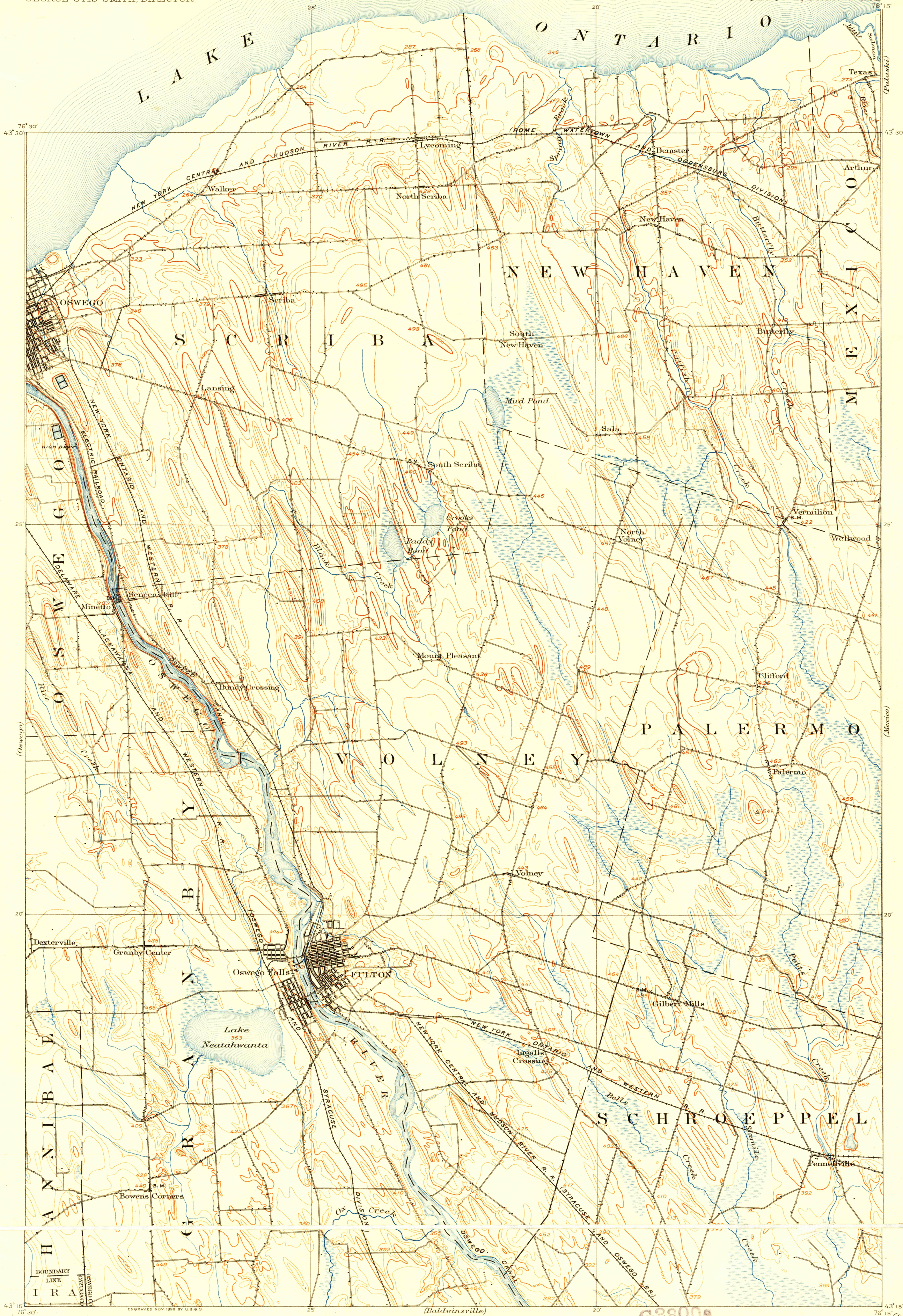

FULTON QUADRANGLE



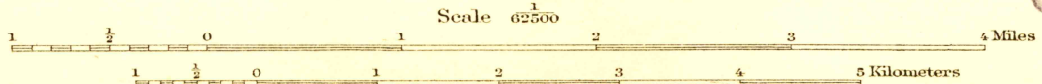
