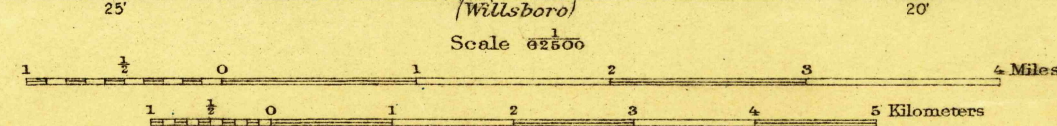
NEW YORK-VERMONT
