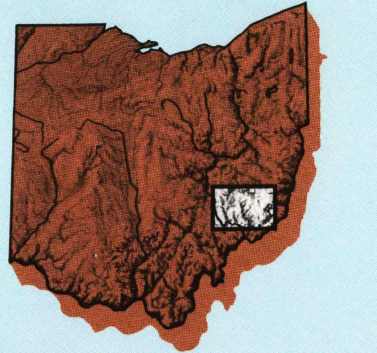
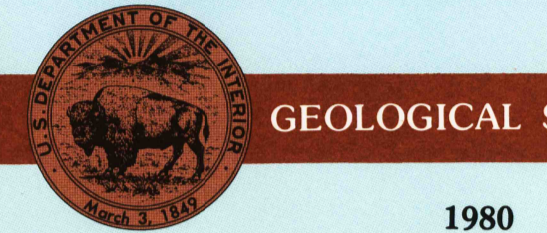


Senecaville Lake OHIO—WEST VIRGINIA 1:100 000-scale metric topographic map
