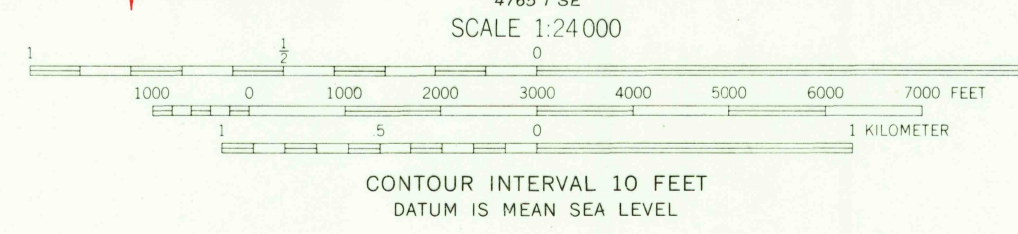

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown. U.S. reservation boundary from maps by U.S. Corps of Engineers. Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation. Land lines within the Connecticut Western Reserve established by private subdivision. Land lines within Congress Lands north of the Old Seven Ranges based on the Ohio River Base.
