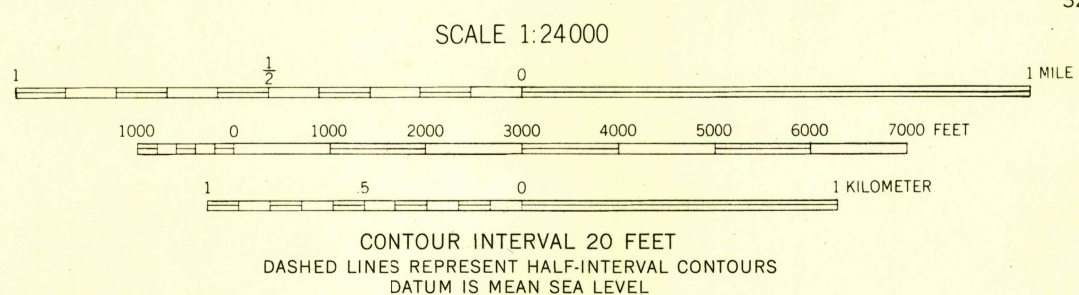




THIS AREA IS SHOWN ON THE MAP OF THE CEREDO QUADRANGLE
