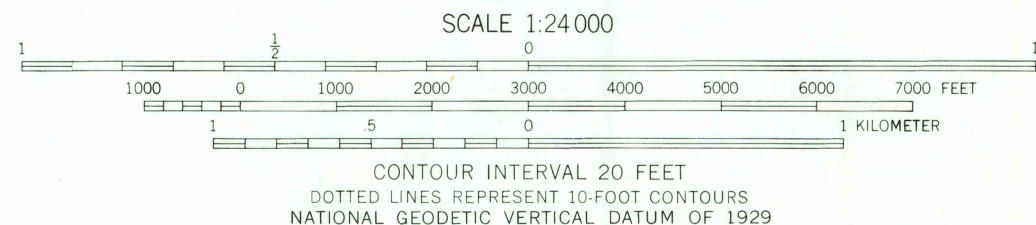
Area east of the Scioto River lies within Congress Lands east of the Scioto River
