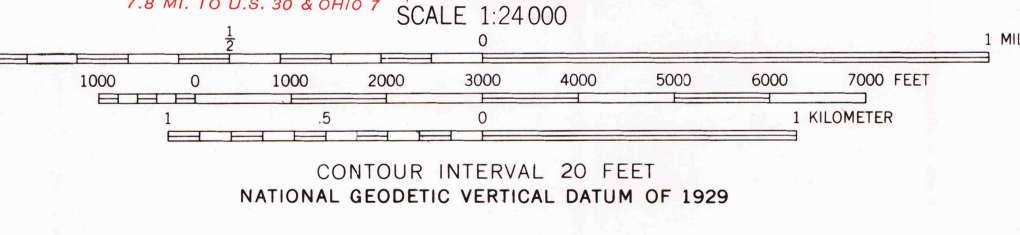

10,000-foot grids based on Ohio coordinate system, north zone, and Pennsylvania coordinate system, south zone
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 3 meters south and 16 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown
Ohio area lies within Congress Lands north of the Old Seven Ranges
Land lines based on the Ohio River Base
