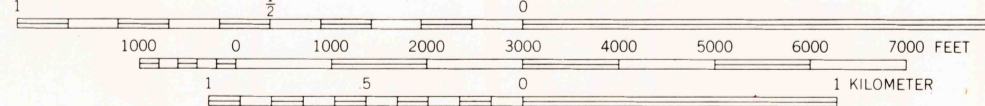
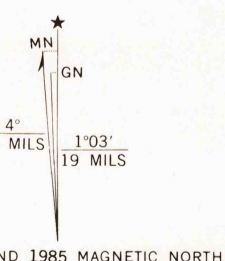
IRONTON QUADRANGLE
