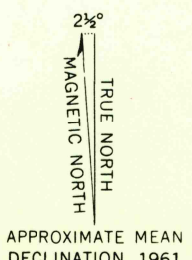
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown

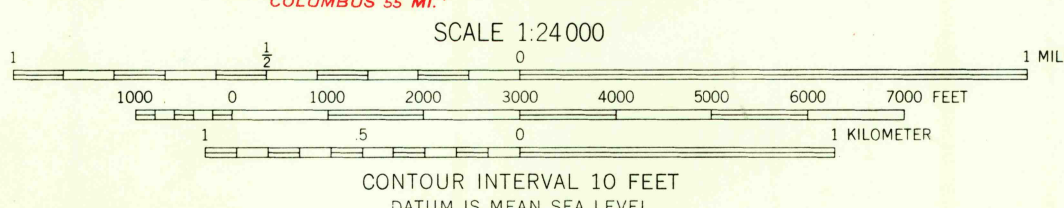
Entire area lies within Congress Lands north of the Old Seven Ranges
