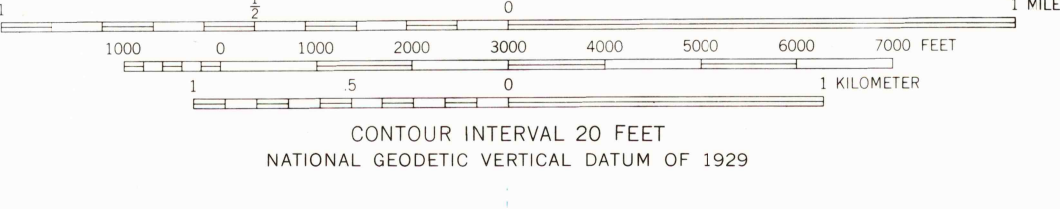
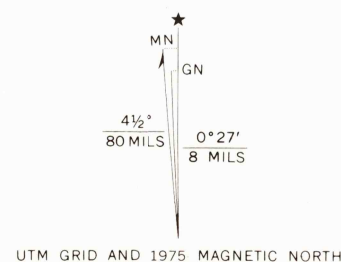
Land lines based on the Base Line of the United States Military District
