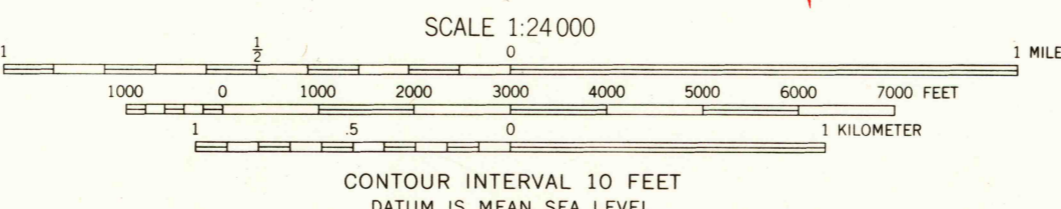

Land lines based on the Great Miami River Base

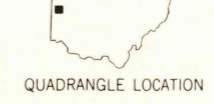
