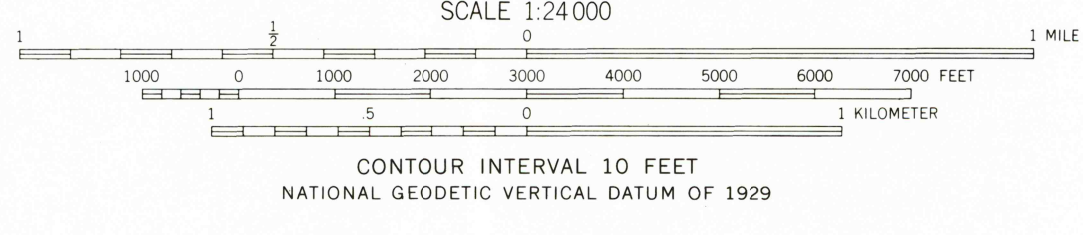
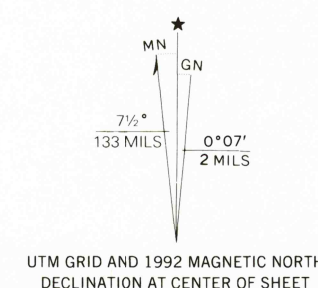

The difference between 1927 North American Datum and North American Datum of 1983 (NAD 83) for 7.5-minute intersections is given in USGS Bulletin 1875. The NAD 83 is shown by dashed corner ticks. Land lines within the Connecticut Western Reserve established by private subdivision. Land lines within Congress Lands north of the Old Seven Ranges based on the Ohio River Base.
