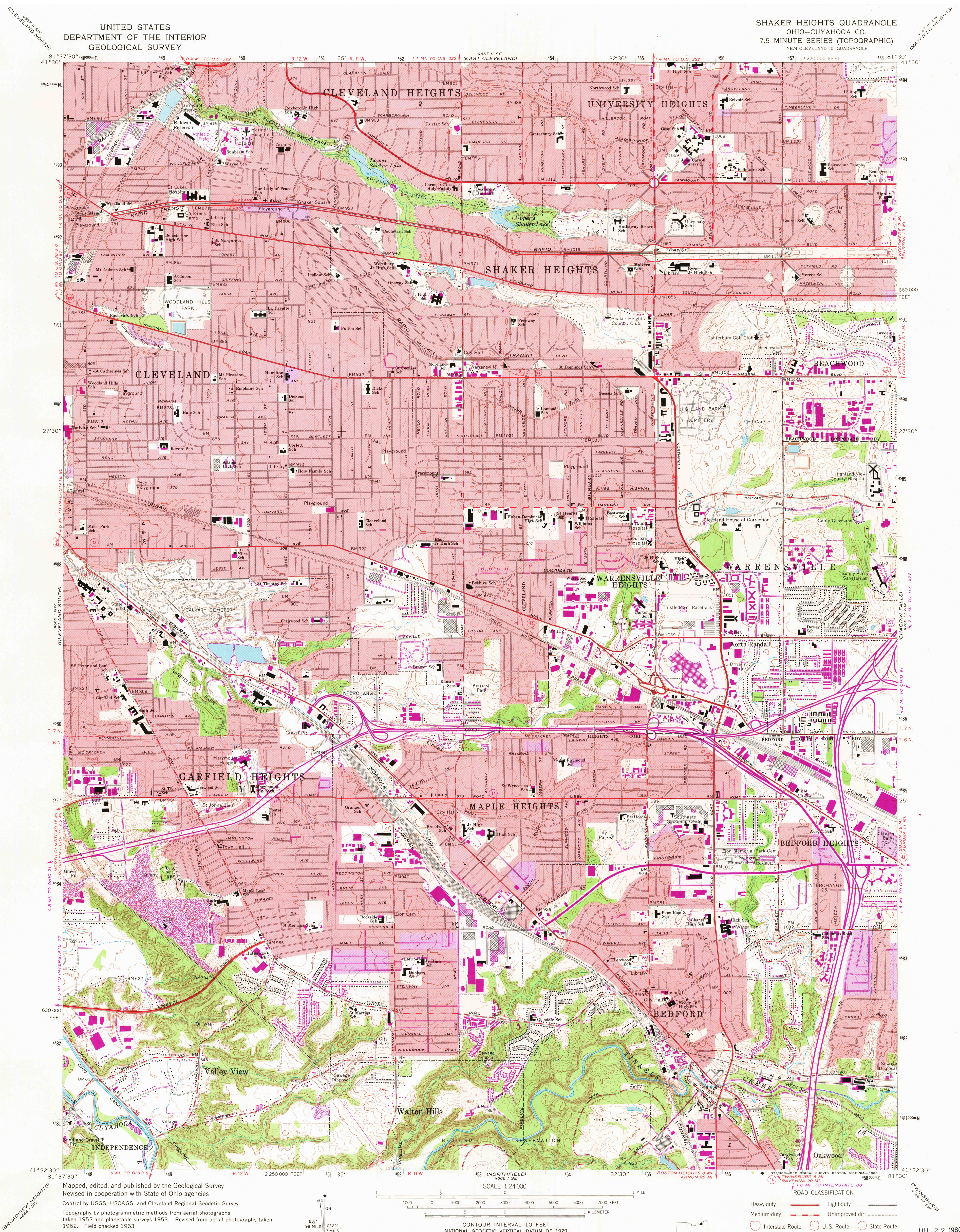


SHAKER HEIGHTS QUADRANGLE
