based on Ohio River Base. Land lines within Connecticut

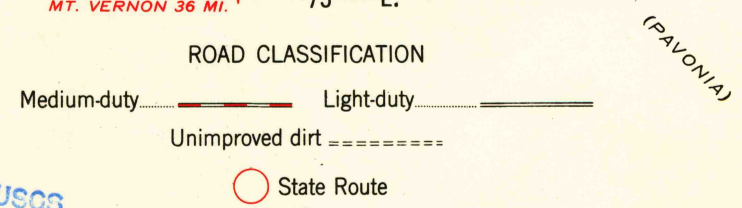
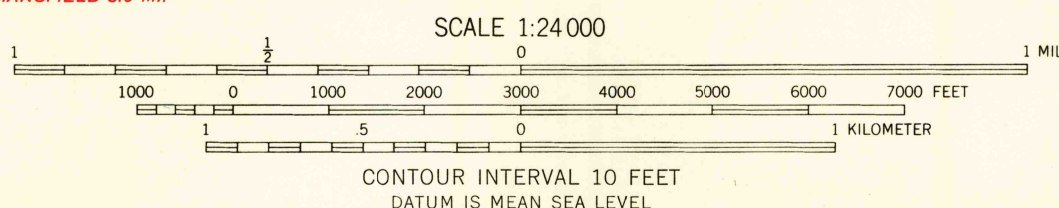
