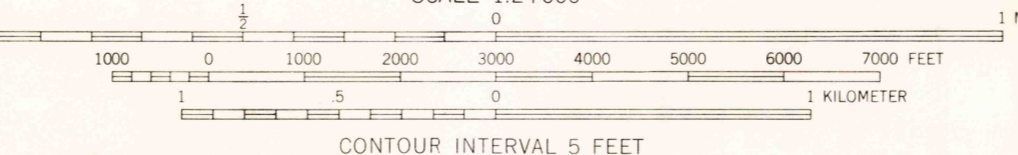
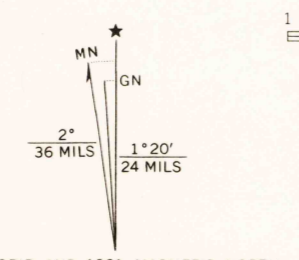
Area south of Greenville Treaty Line lies within the United States Military District Land lines based on the Base Line of the United States Military District
