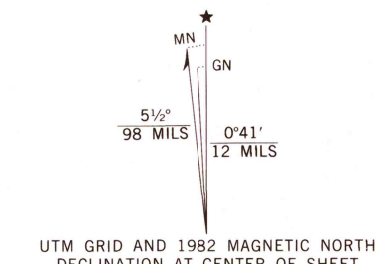

generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked.
Entire area lies within the United States Military District
Land lines based on the Base Line of the United States Military District
Area covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled
inundation.
