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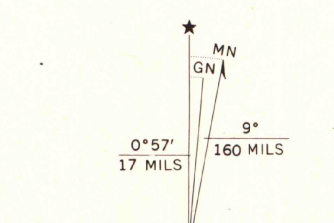

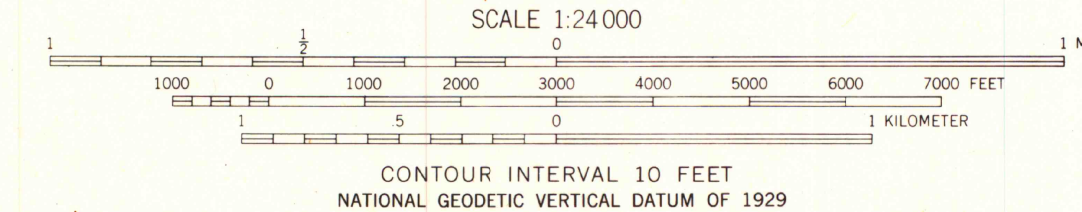

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 7 meters south and 26 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks



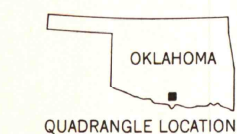
UTM GRID AND 1969 MAGNETIC NORTH DECLINATION AT CENTER OF SHEET
