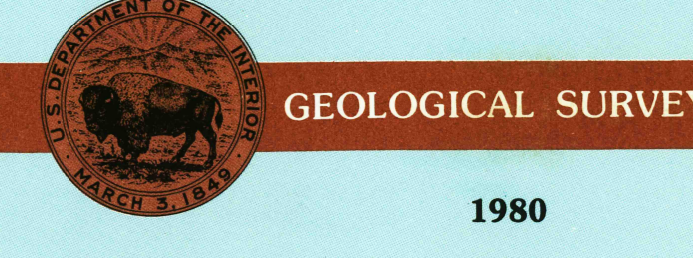


1:100 000-scale metric topographic map of **Waldport OREGON**

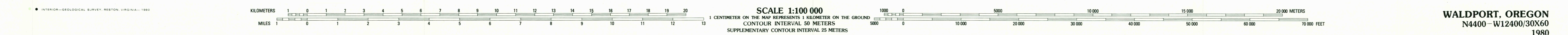
