

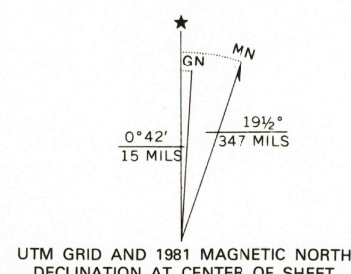

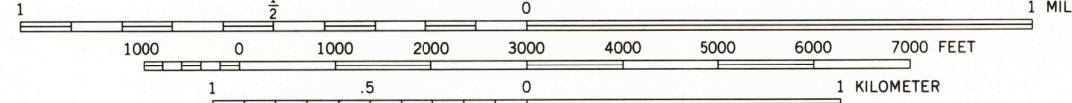
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American Datum, 10,000-foot grid based on Oregon coordinate system, south zone
