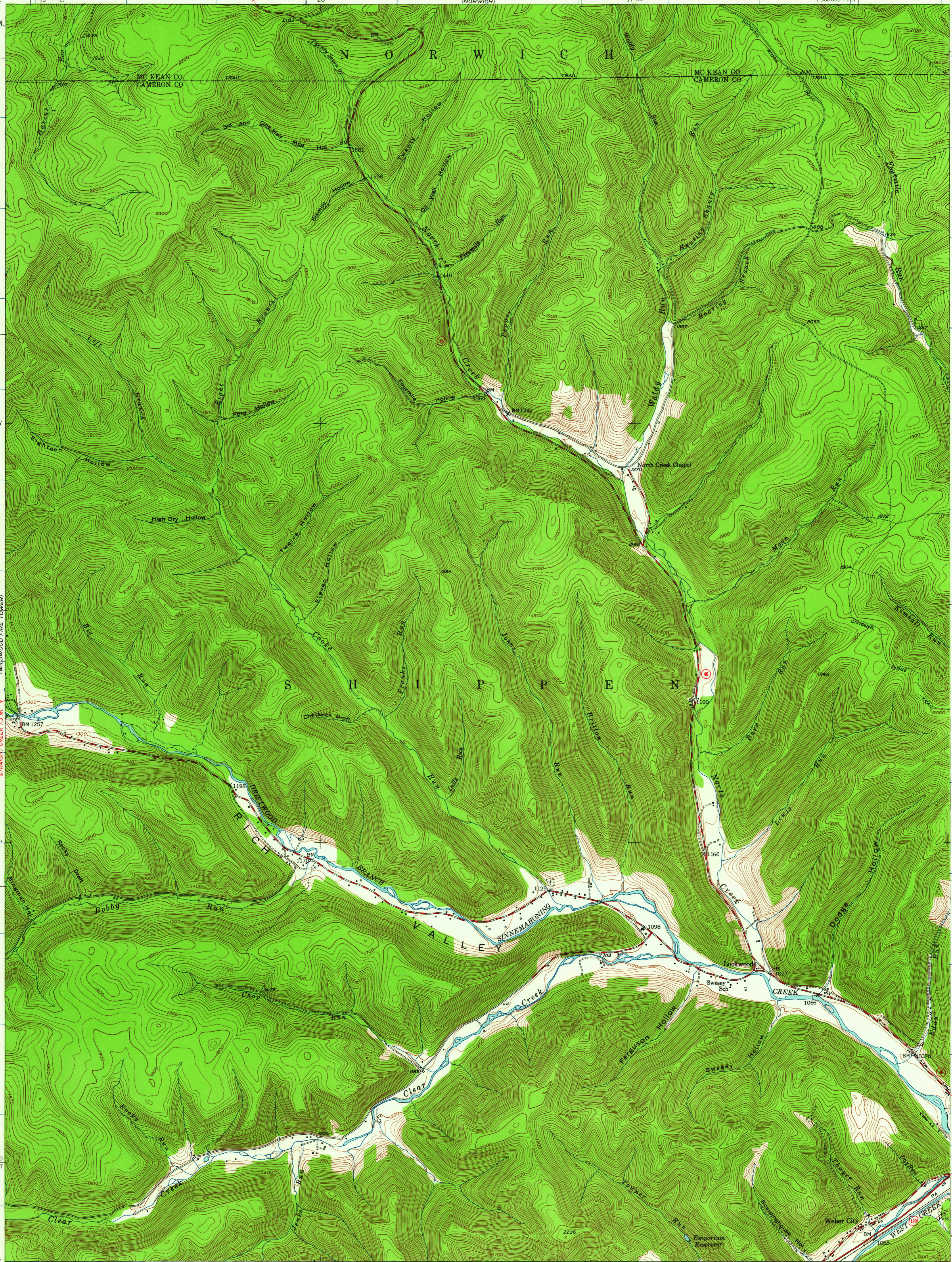

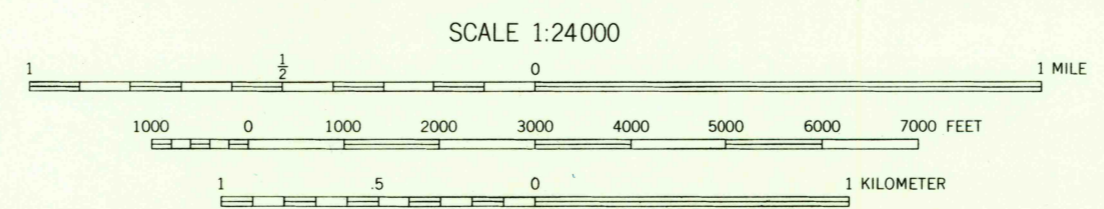

KEATING SUMMIT

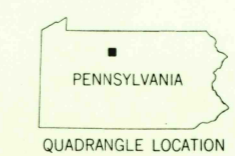
